

CHATEAU MUSAR RED 1978

Tasting Note

Robe d'une teinte riche grenat pourpe fonce.

Nez ample et epanoui. Notes grillees, d'epices sechees (canelle, cardamone..)

Bouche d'aspect riche, avec des notes chaudes d'epices caramelisees. Caractere ferme et long.

Excellente retro-olfaction aux saveurs grillees, ameres/confites (agrumes).

Finale chaude.

Medium colour showing some maturity – bright, deep orange/red. Sweet and full bodied with flavours of charcoal and creamy cassis, spiced, nutty oak with firm dry tannins and a long rasping finish.

Very well balanced – an outstanding wine.

Considered by many to be a classic vintage of Chateau Musar, the acidity is definite but not excessive and this vintage has a lot of depth and richness of flavour. It is velvety in the mouth, beautifully balanced with a long warm finish.
