**CHATEAU MUSAR RED 1985**

**Tasting Note**

Good conditions in the winter followed by a fresh summer with a small crop. Unfortunately this was one of the smallest vintages in the 1980's and going back as far as 1975.

A classical vintage made with no major problems - with one great exception: its size.

Medium to full colour, very fine bouquet leading to a well balanced, tannic wine. Very well structured with great ageing potential. A wine that will last and reward patient keeping.

Update from Serge Hochar in April 2000

Powerful, the characteristics of this wine have not changed much in the last 5 years, however Serge believes this vintage has still to develop its full potential.
