Chateau Musar White 1980

The color is a yellow golden color, almost honey like.

The nose is of very matured fruits, apricots and pears, a powerful caramel fragrance combined with honey, a hint of matured figs at the end.

The taste is very powerful for a 30 years old white wine, a crispy acidity combined with citrus and apricots flavors and a taste of figs, a long finish of grapefruit and green pomegranate, completely different from what you expect after smelling the wine; a big wine reflecting the power of the merwah grape and the Lebanese Mount-Lebanon microclimate.

A wine to serve at cellar temperature (15°C) and to decant before serving.
