

# Chateau Musar White 1970



## Overview

Chateau Musar White is made with the fruit from Merwah vines - an ancient varietal indigenous to Lebanon and grown around 1200-1400 metres above sea level on the slopes of Mount Lebanon. The vines are ungrafted so remain on their original rootstocks.

## Winemaking

Fermented with natural yeasts and aged in bottle prior to release.

## Tasting Notes

An orange yellow colour.

The nose is of vanilla, wax, with a hint of mushrooms and truffles and a presence of white prunes.

The palate shows some honey and vanilla with very round tannins and a presence of quince, apricots and a long after-taste of vanilla.

## Alcohol

12.5% Alc./Vol.
